Legal basis for data processing:

- Article 6(1)(f) GDPR ("Balancing of interests").
- Section 4 German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG)

Purposes of the processing:

- Protection of property rights
- Legitimate interests, in particular:
 - Clarification in the event of break-in, theft and material damage
 - Accident & personal protection
 - Preservation of evidence
 - Access control
 - Entry and exit controls
 - Prevent recourse claims

Recipients (categories) of personal data:

In principle, data will not be disclosed provided that no event involving any of the protection purposes has occurred. However, in the event of an occurrence, disclosure may be made to internal or external investigating authorities for clarification.

Storage period:

In principle, records are kept for a maximum of 48 hours and then automatically deleted. In the event of an occurrence of an incident (see Purposes), the information concerned will be held until clarification or the end of legal deadlines and will then be deleted manually.

Your rights – rights of the data subject under the GDPR:

Articles 12 - 23 GDPR regulate the rights of the data subject, i.e. your rights regarding the handling of your personal data. With regard to us, the most important of these are:

- Right of access to information according to Article 15 GDPR
- Right to correction in accordance with Article 16 GDPR
- Right to deletion according to Article 17 GDPR
- Right to restriction of the processing according to Article 18 GDPR
- Where applicable: Right to data portability according to Article 20 GDPR
- Right to object to the processing according to Article 21 GDPR
- Right to lodge a complaint: In accordance with Article 13(2)(d) GDPR, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a data protection supervisory authority. You can find a list of data protection commissioners in Germany and their contact information at the following link:
