

## COMPLIANCE DECLARATION TO EU RoHS DIRECTIVE 2011/65/EU

### OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 8 June 2011

The EU RoHS Directive (2011/65/EU) and its amendment (EU) 2015/863, as well as the Swiss ChemRRV, provide that manufacturers of electrical and electronic equipment and their respective sub-assemblies, components and spare parts must issue a declaration of conformity stating that their products comply with the prohibition on hazardous substances. These obligations have been autonomously implemented into the Swiss ordinance on reduction of chemical risks (ChemRRV) and have thus applied to companies in Switzerland since December 1<sup>st</sup> 2012.

In particular, the following substances are restricted with specified limits of concentration value in homogeneous materials (maximum concentration values tolerated by weight):

- Lead (Pb) 0.1 %
- Mercury (Hg) 0.1 %
- Cadmium (Cd) 0.01 %
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr6+) 0.1 %
- Poly Brominated Biphenyls (PBB) 0.1 %
- Poly Brominated Diphenyl Ether (PBDE) 0.1 %
- Bis (2-ethylhexyl) Phthalate (DEHP) 0.1 %
- Butyl Benzyl Phthalate (BBP) 0.1 %
- Dibutyl Phthalate (DBP) 0.1 %
- Diisobutyl Phthalate (DIBP) 0.1 %

As part of Schneeberger's procurement of products, our suppliers have to acknowledge the conformity with the above directives. SCHNEEBERGER AG Lineartechnik is assembling products without subsequent modification of purchased Products. As internal Processes do not affect RoHS conformity, SCHNEEBERGER AG Lineartechnik confirms that products and materials supplied are compliant **at all times, regardless of the date of issue stated below**, with the RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU and its amendment (EU) 2015/863 without any exemptions.
